**ELIGIBILITY** Open to all Washington metropolitan area residents, age 55 and above.

**SALES** The label affixed to each work shall indicate a determined sales price or the words "Not for sale." All sales will be by arrangement between the prospective buyer and the artist. Artists are responsible for collecting Virginia sales tax. Determined price may not be changed once the exhibit begins. Sold artwork must remain in the exhibit until the end of the show.

**LIABILITY** Senior Services of Alexandria, Goodwin House Foundation, The Art League, Inc., The Alexandria Commission on Aging, Friends of the Torpedo Factory Art Center, RSVP, The Alexandria Commission for the Arts, and/or The City of Alexandria cannot be held responsible for damage or theft of the exhibited work. Entering the show constitutes agreement with the above conditions. All unclaimed artwork will be charged a storage fee of \$50.00 per weekday.

**WARRANTY** The Lender/Artist warrants that s/he is the creator of and holds full and clear title to the Objects/Artwork to be exhibited.

**ARTIST'S AGREEMENT** Artists must deliver and pick up art work on the dates and times indicated on the Entry Form. Accepted work must be left in the exhibit until October 30, 2009. Artists agree to grant permission for their art work to be photographed for publicity purposes.

**RETURN OF ARTWORK** Objects/Artwork will be returned to the Lender/Artist at The Durant Center, 1605 Cameron Street, Alexandria, VA from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m., October 30, 2009. If legal ownership or authority to act in behalf of the legal owner should change, whether by reason of sale, death, gift, or otherwise, the new owner or agent may be required to establish a legal right to receive the Objects/Artwork by satisfactory proof. If the Lender/Artist fails to take possession of the Objects/Artwork and if efforts to contact the Lender/Artist or Owner at the expiration of the loan period are unsuccessful, the Objects/Artwork will be placed in storage at the Lender/Artist or Owner's risk and expense. If after one year the property is not reclaimed, it shall then become an unrestricted gift to Senior Services of Alexandria.

The 23<sup>rd</sup> annual **Young at Art** show opens on Monday, August 3, 2009 at the Durant Recreation Center, 1605 Cameron Street and runs through October 30. The **YOUNG AT ART** Opening Reception and Awards Ceremony will be held on Thursday, August 6, 2009 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., also at Durant Recreation Center.

The juried show is open to all metro artists ages 55 and older. Isabella Hughes, Associate Gallery Director at The Art League Gallery in Alexandria, Virginia will serve as the juror.

Ms. Hughes, who holds a BA in Art History from Boston University, is currently an Associate Gallery Director at The Art League Gallery in Alexandria, Virginia and is a free lance curator. She has enjoyed working with the visual arts in various capacities at the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston, the Institute for Contemporary Art, the Boston Center for the Arts, and the Vera List Center for Art and Politics in New York City. She is serving as co-curator of "I Ran Home", an exhibit on Iranian Diaspora culture, diplomacy, and art which will open in Berlin, Germany in March 2010.

**YOUNG AT ART** has consistently attracted accomplished artists who work in all mediums. Works by teachers, professionals and amateurs have been submitted and accepted.

This is the second year that Senior Services of Alexandria (SSA) and Goodwin House Foundation (GHF) have co-sponsored the show. When "RSVP," (Retired Senior Volunteer Program) was looking for a new sponsor for the show in 2008, both Goodwin House Foundation and Senior Services of Alexandria were at the ready. "We are delighted to work with SSA, and carry on the tradition of RSVP's desire to showcase the works of talented local artists," said Jeanne Jacob, Executive Director of Goodwin House Foundation.

- AWARDS** Cash prizes will be awarded in the following amounts: First Place - \$150.00 and a one-year membership in The Art League, Inc.; Second Place - \$125.00; Third Place - \$100.00; and five Honorable Mentions.
- SALES** All sales will be by arrangement between the prospective buyer and the artist. Artists are responsible for collecting Virginia sales tax. Sold artwork must remain in the exhibit until the end of the show. A fee of 10% of the sales price (pre tax) shall be donated to Senior Services of Alexandria.
- ENTRY REQUIREMENTS** Open to original works of art. Work must not have been entered in prior **YOUNG AT ART** exhibits. Two-dimensional works must be framed and matted if appropriate, and be wired and ready to hang.
- HOW TO ENTER** Complete the attached Entry Form and submit it with the artwork upon delivery to The Durant Center. An entry fee of \$20.00 per artist covers up to three works of art. Additional works may be submitted with a fee of \$15.00 each. Checks only, please, made payable to Senior Services Alexandria. Entry fees are non-refundable. Each piece must have a completed label attached to the upper left-hand corner on the back of two-dimensional work or on the bottom of three-dimensional work.
